- **Shelter-Housing-Food**
Hear from local providers of shelter services, housing programs, aging services and food security efforts while gaining insight from individuals who have walked through these programs and services.
- **Youth**
Engage in genuine discussions about youth homelessness, services within our community, issues that are unique to youth and hear from youth with lived experience who have walked through this system, sharing their ideas for improvement.
- **Medical-Behavioral Health-Substance Use Treatment**
Learn from providers about treatment options available in Carroll County and how to navigate them. This panel will bring an authentic voice of people that access these services and their experience.
- **Education-Workforce**
Discover educational and workforce development opportunities across Carroll County. Learn about what skills make a valuable job candidate and what training may enhance marketability. We will share where to start and what it takes to enroll/engage in these opportunities, many of which are short-term and may be free.
