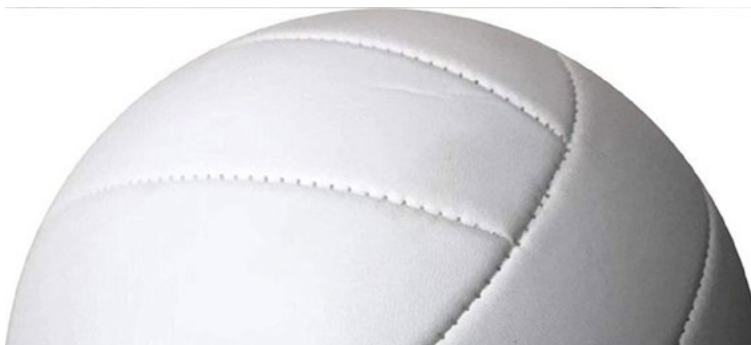

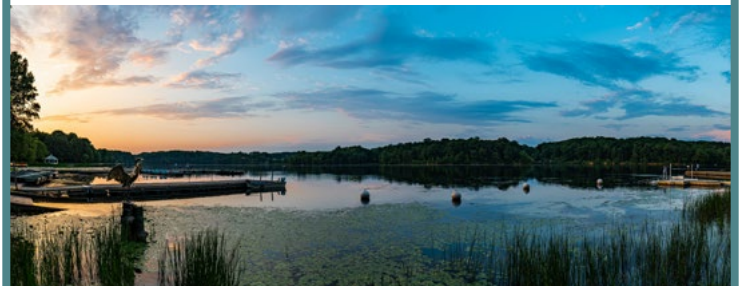

WITHDRAW/REFUND POLICY
