South Branch Patapsco Tree Planting Krimgold Park

This planting on property owned by the Carroll County Commissioners in the South Branch Patapsco watershed was completed in Fall 2024 as part of a larger tree planting effort. The benefits of tree plantings include providing for a reduction of pollutant loads, stabilization, and improved habitat.

Resource Management staff worked with Recreation & Parks staff to determine the potential planting areas, native plant species, and the ultimate vision for the property. This planting resulted in the reforestation of **1.68 acres** with **500** trees planted.
